NEW for 2009 - *Group rates* are now available for all shows/events ordered through the Tulip Time Office, see page 2 for group price list. Groups of 15 or more guests receive a discount of \$1 off parade/quilt show tickets, and \$2 off all other show tickets ordered through the Tulip Time Office. Groups of 15 or more guests will also receive up to 2 *comp tickets* per show/event for the escort and driver, including our group meal program held at area churches and Hope College! Group orders will be reserved with full payment and mailed *after* the refund date of April 6, 2009.

Jan Mulder, a globally recognized pianist born and raised in the Netherlands, will share his talents with us on Saturday, May 2 at 7:30pm. *1964 The Tribute*, the #1 Beatles show in the world, will be performing Sunday, May 3 at 6pm. *New Odyssey* will be returning for our dinner show, but has added a *show only* performance for Saturday, May 2 at 7:30pm.

CHANGES for 2009 - Our Friday headliner, The Oak Ridge Boys, will only be offering 1 show at 8pm. Barbershop on Parade has been moved to the last Saturday of the festival, May 9 at 7:30pm. Klompen Dancing prior to the Volksparade and Muziekparade will be held on 8th Street between River and Columbia Avenues, rather than in front of the bleachers. Step-on Guide tours are now \$85.

Please retain a copy of order form for your records. **Groups:** Group rates and comps are not available by ordering online. Orders are not considered complete until full payment is received. Group orders will be mailed after the refund date, April 6, 2009.

REFUNDS - Refunds are available until April 6, 2009, less a 5% handling fee. Returned tickets must be in the Tulip Time office by April 6, 2009. No exceptions. Sara will be calling groups the first week in April for changes in numbers. In the unfortunate event of a severe illness, injury or death, which directly prevents a visitor from attending the festival, refunds are available less the 5% handling fee. To qualify for this type of refund a doctor's note or a copy of a death certificate must be mailed with all tickets to the Tulip Time Festival office by June 15, 2009. Customers are asked to please notify the office as soon as possible so that tickets may be re-sold if time allows.
