NEW for 2010 - For the first time we welcome as our headliners *The Coasters, Drifters & Platters* for Thursday, May 6 and *Starship* for Friday, May 7, 2010. We are also excited to have *Wally's Warehouse Waifs* on Wednesday, May 5. Local churches will be serving lunches in a buffet format in 2010 to better meet the growing needs of today's travellers. Lunch buffet items will differ from dinner buffet items, however both will include hot, home-cooked options.

CHANGES for 2010 - Our Thursday headliner, *The Coasters, Drifters & Platters*, will only be offering 1 show at 7pm. *Barbershop* has been moved to the first Saturday of the festival, May 1 at 7pm. Klompen Dancing prior to the Volksparade and Muziekparade will be held on 8th Street between River and Columbia Avenues, rather than in front of the bleachers. *New Odyssey* will be returning for our dinner show, however will ONLY be performing Wednesday, May 5 through Saturday, May 8. The *Quilt Show* will be held at a new location, the Holland Area Arts Council.

Due to Hope College still being in session during the festival in 2010 we will not be able to offer *A Taste of Holland* or group meals at the college. This is temporary for 2010 only. Local churches will continue to serve groups lunch and dinner as they have for 54 years. The Lion's Club will also be serving dinner May 5-8.

This year's refund date is April 1, 2010.

GROUP RATES- Groups of 20 or more guests receive special pricing and 2 comp tickets per show/event for the escort and driver for all tickets purchased through the Tulip Time Festival office. This comp policy also applies to our group meal program held at area churches and the Lion's Club! Group tickets will be reserved with full payment and mailed after the refund date of April 1, 2010.
