

## Kinder Dutch Dance

Here are a few things to look for on how your child's costume should fit at inspection:

Please note that these lists are not all inclusive but highlight areas that most often cause difficulty. Additional details are included on spec sheets for individual costumes.

**Girl's Spakenburg:** Hat fits snug around the face, and sits just above the ear lobes.

Length of dress is  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch above the top of wooden shoes, while tried on with all socks and child standing and looking straight forward. You should fit approximately 1 to 2 finger widths between the skirt and shoes.

Apron is 2 inches shorter than the dress.

Apron closes comfortably just meeting in the back, without overlapping, pulling, or looking too tight.

Make sure all snaps and hooks are securely sewn on.

**Boy's Spakenburg:** Hat fits properly on head, not too big.

The shirt is worn un-tucked and fits a bit loose. The seam by the shoulder/sleeve hangs off the shoulder by about 1 inch.

The neck and sleeves can all be buttoned comfortably.

The length of the sleeve just covers the bony part of the wrist when arm is extended.

Length of pants is  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch above wooden shoes, while tried on with all socks and child standing and looking straight forward. You should fit just 1 to 2 finger widths between the pants and shoes.

All buttons and hooks are sewed on.
